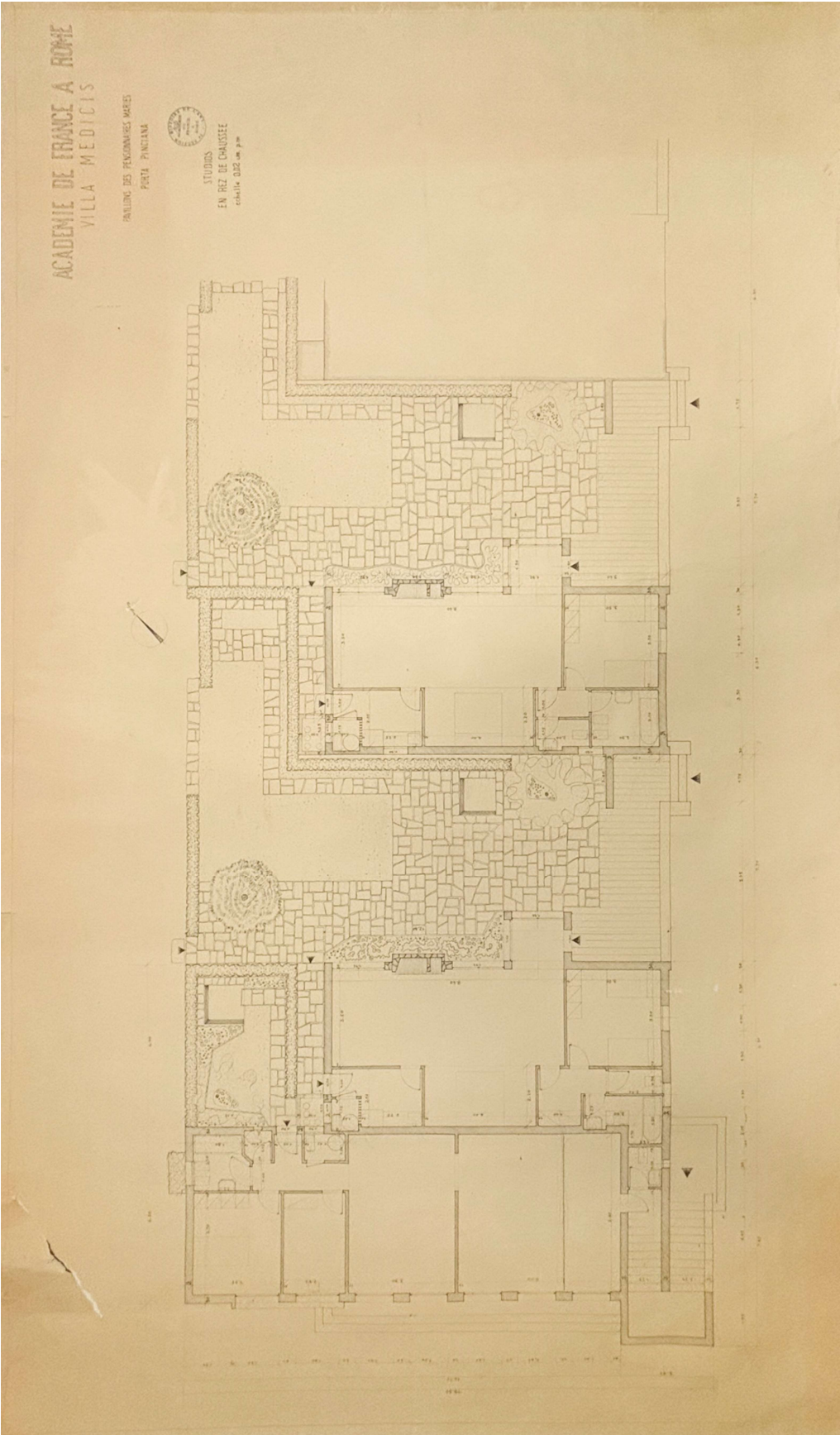

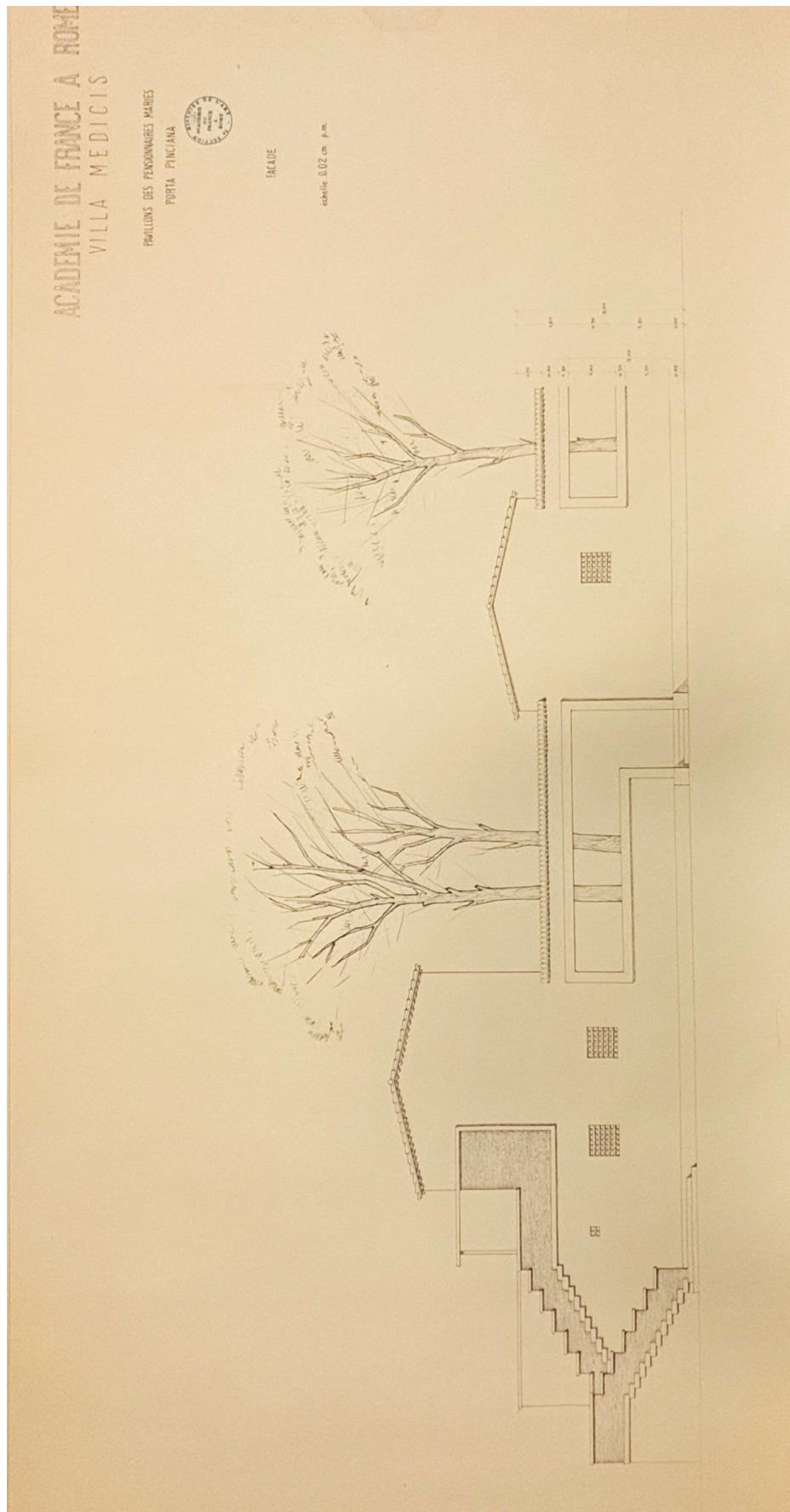

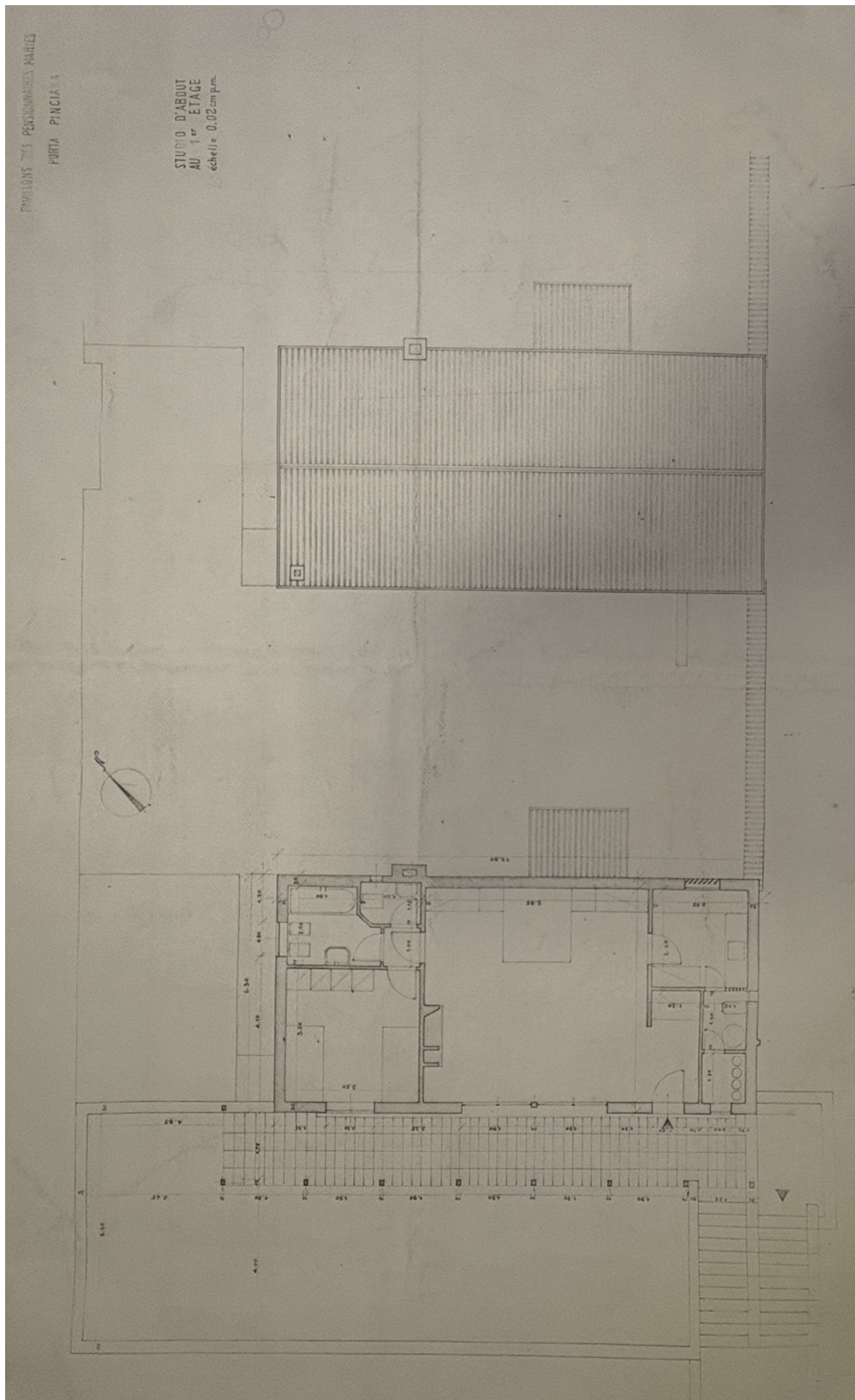

Preliminary design no. 2: Elevation of the south facade of the pavilions, 1954, Jacques Carlu. Source: AFR.

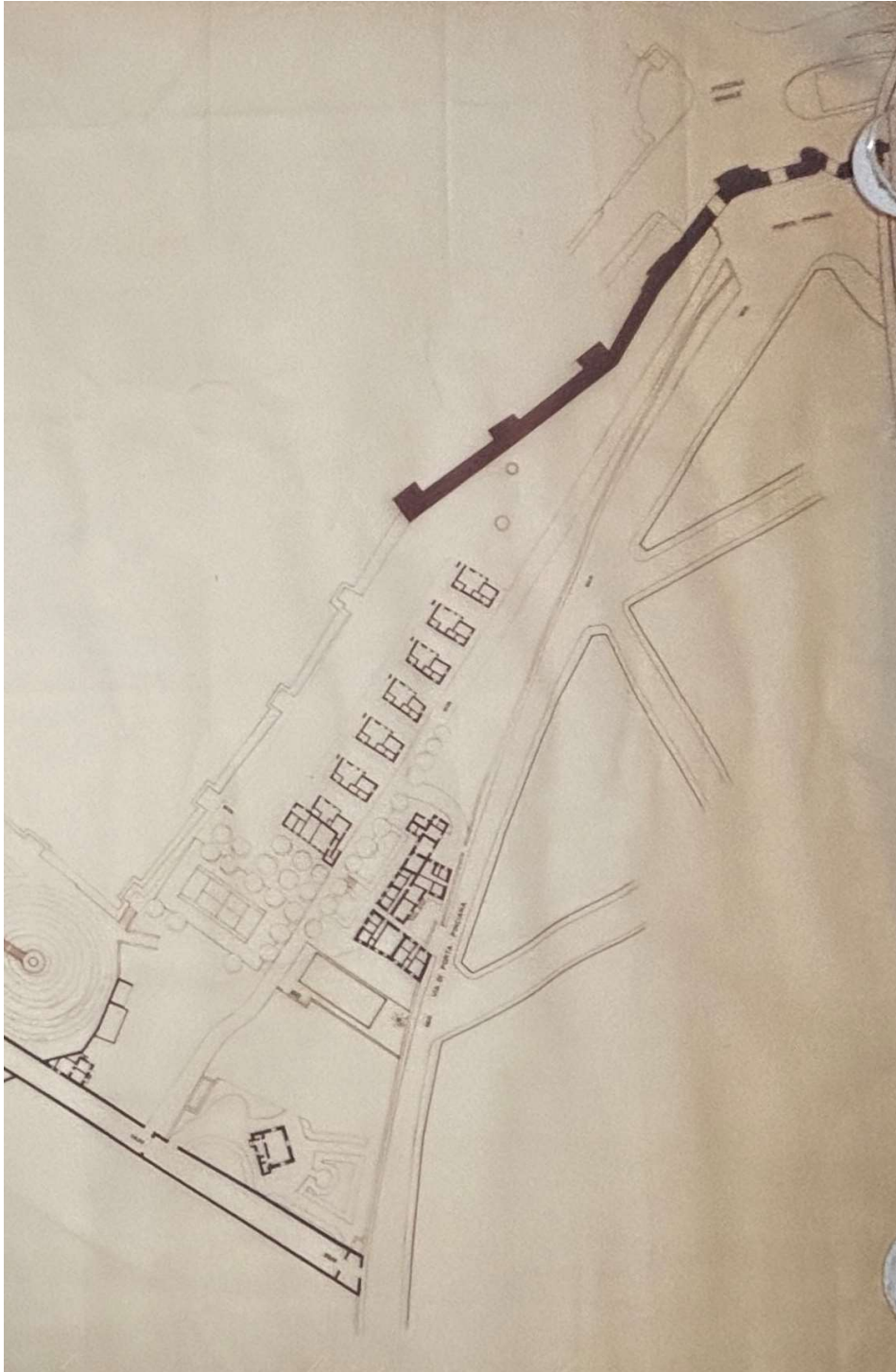


Preliminary design no. 2: Floor plan of the end pavilion, 1954, Jacques Carlu. Source: AFR.

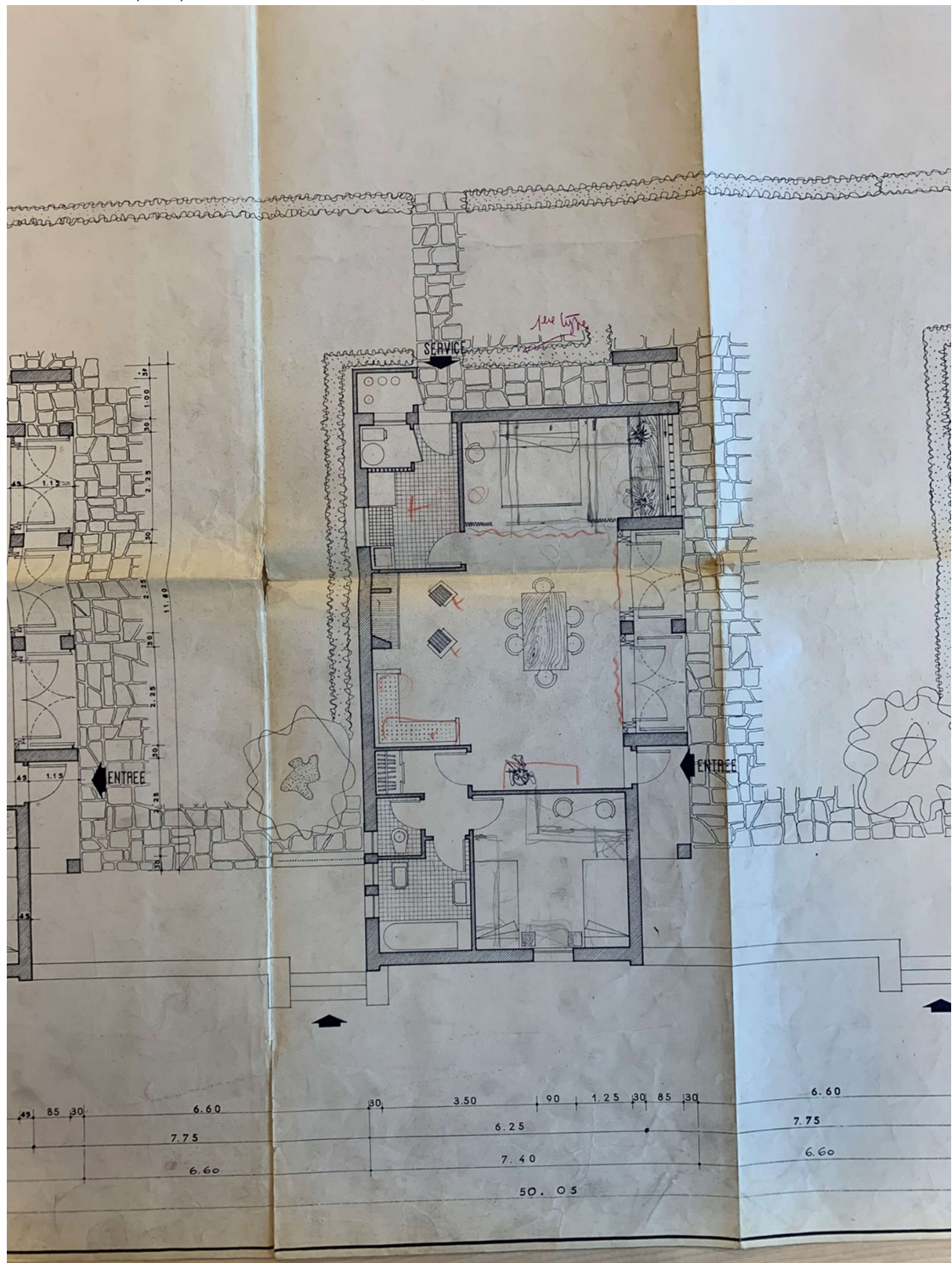


Final site plan of the pavilions, 1955, Jacques Carlu.

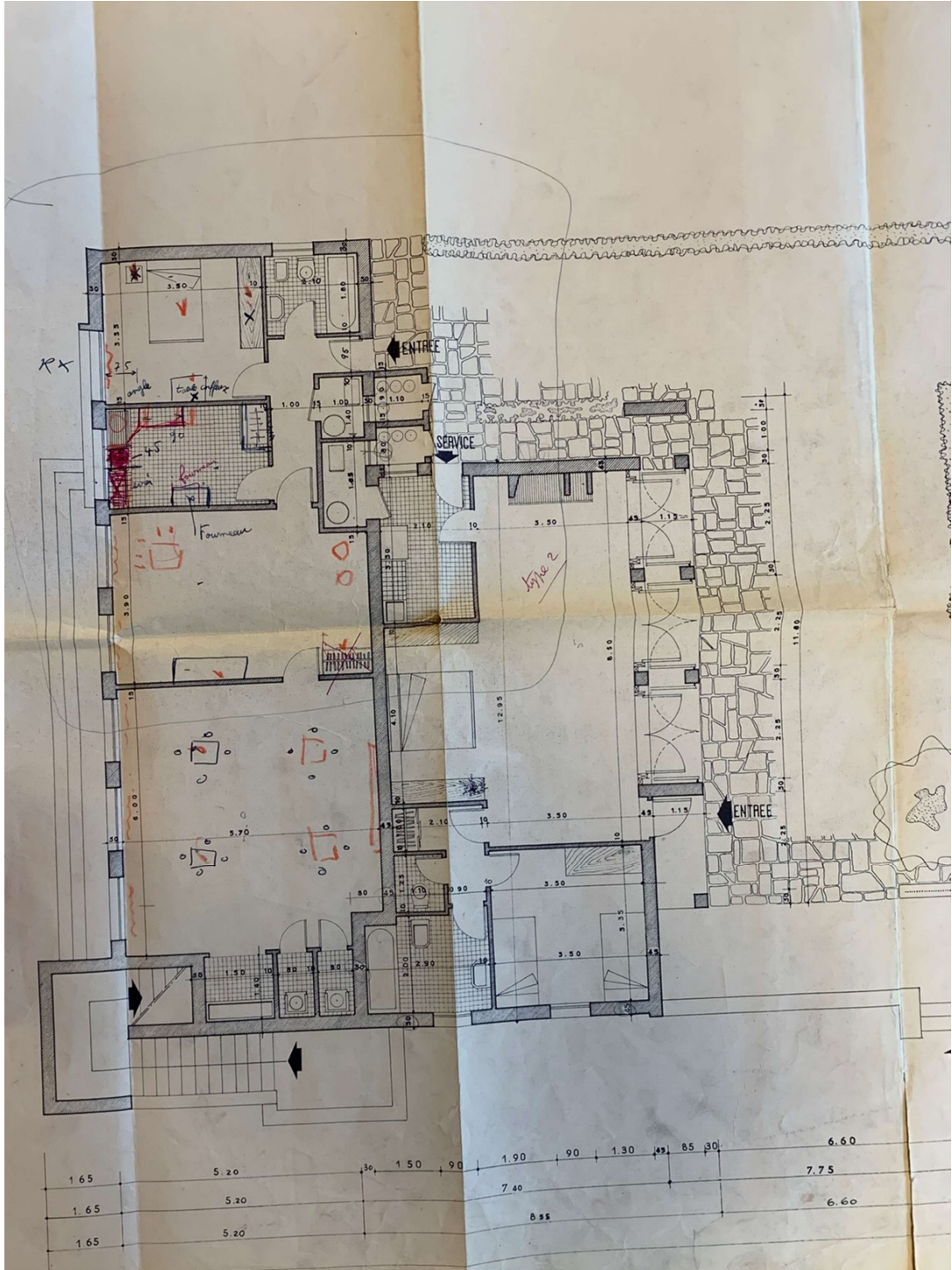

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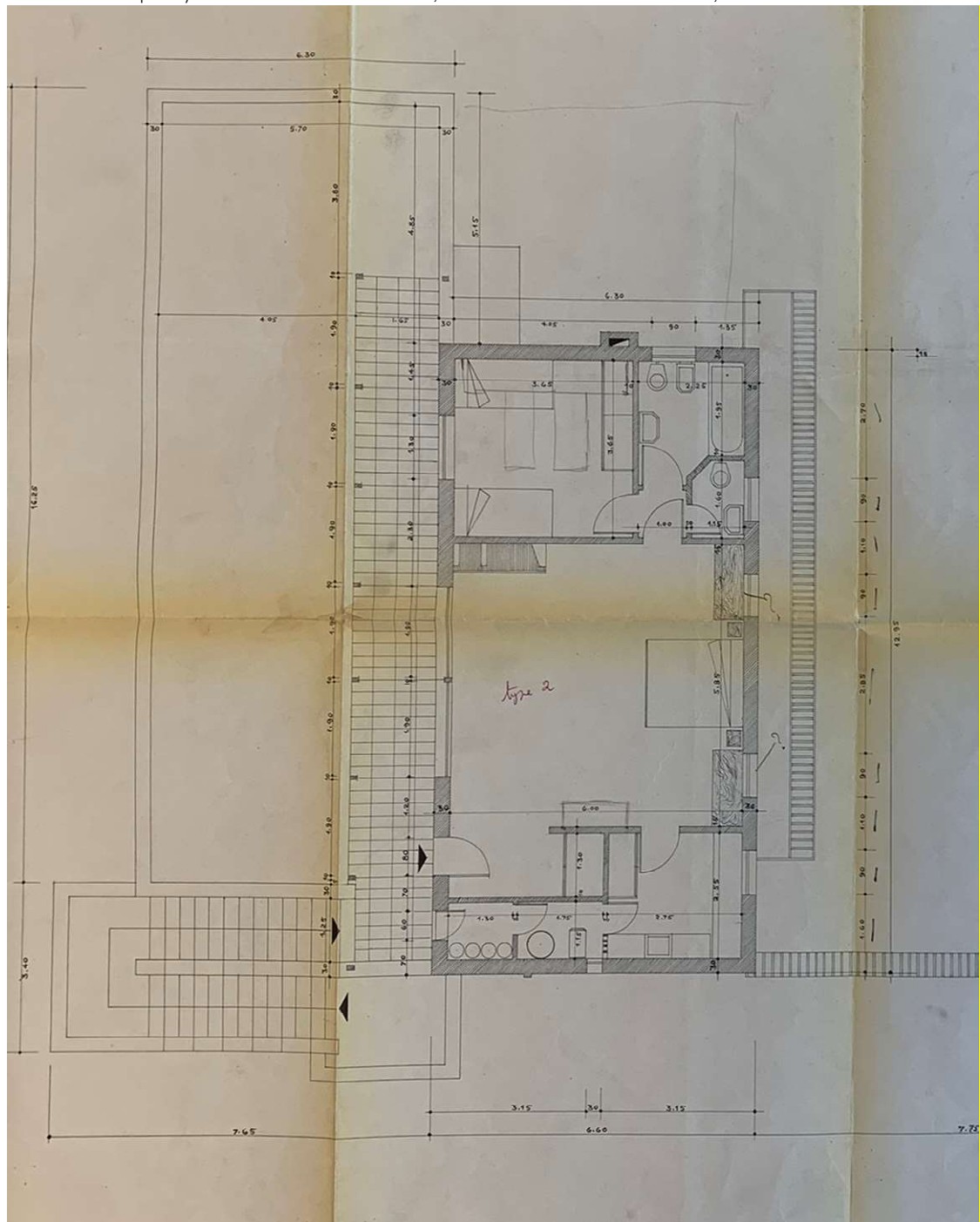
Final ground floor plan of the end pavilion (G, I), 1955, Jacques Carlu.
